Ways to Update Your Info:

What to Update:

Report any important changes:

- Your address
- Your income
- Your expenses (e.g. rent, child care payments)

Texans should report up-to-date information to HHSC as soon as possible so that they are receiving all benefits for which they are eligible.

Families were getting extra help during the pandemic. Extra SNAP payments ended in February 2023. now, Texans will only receive their regular SNAP payment on their EBT card. take action! report up-to-date info to HHSC as soon as possible so you receive all benefits for which you are eligible.

UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION

It's important for you to report changes in your info to HHSC to make sure your family is receiving the right amount of benefits.

Ways to update your information:

Mobile App: Your Texas Benefits Mobile App

Website: Access YourTexasBenefits account on yourtexasbenefits.com

Call: Call 2-1-1 and select Option 2 to update your information



Visit: Visit your local HHSC benefits office to report changes in-person. Scan the code to find a location near you!

P-EBT: HELP FOR FAMILIES

Time is running out to claim your kids Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) benefits. Claim your code now for \$391!

If your child attended a Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school during School Year 2021-2022, but your household has never received benefits through SNAP or P-EBT, you should have received a letter in the mail with a six-character claim code. You can redeem your P-EBT benefits by creating an account on YourTexasBenefits.com or by calling the P-EBT Call Center at 833-442-1255.

There is no additional application. You have 90 days from the date the letter was received to claim your code. Act now – claim codes will expire as soon.

COLLEGE SNAP CHANGES

The rules about SNAP eligibility for students are changing, and some students may no longer be eligible. You may need to provide additional information to your caseworker when you recertify in order to continue your SNAP benefits.

If your certification period ends in April, May or June, and you recertify for SNAP by June 30, 2023 and you are still considered a student, you may still qualify under the temporary student rules. Complete your recertification as normal.

If you recertify for SNAP after June 30, 2023, and you are still considered a student, you must meet a student exemption. As always, students must also meet all other SNAP eligibility requirements to receive SNAP.
